- 2. Document Verification
- 3. Physical measurement test (PMT) (Check Height, Weight and Chest)
- **4.** Physical fitness test (PFT)
- 5. Viva
- 6. Online MCQ exam (Link will be published on Website)
- 7. Merit List generation
- 8. Merit List on Website.
- 9. List of Selected Candidate on Website.

Special Instruction:

- Applications are invited from eligible and interested candidate of FY BA/B.Sc/BCA Sem-1 of DKV Arts and Science College, Jamnagar for recruitment of SD & SW Cadets in NCC can apply Online.
- 2. Online registration is mandatory and will be open from 07 OCT 2021 to 10 OCT 2021.
- Personnel e-mail ID is MUST. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID. NCC Office will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong / changed).
- 4. Candidates should reach the venue on given date and time as mentioned in the Prospectus.
- 5. Candidates are required to report at the NCC Office by **07:45 am** on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after **08:00 am** without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the selection Process.
- 6. Candidate should have a good knowledge of English and Hindi.
- 7. Result of online MCQ exam, Merit list and Selected Candidate list will be declared on the official website of the College.
- 8. Mobile phones are not permitted in selection area.
- 9. Candidates are advised to bring sufficient eatables and drinking water with them as recruitment is a time consuming process.
- **10.** Candidates will be allowed to enter the selection venue only on the basis of FY BA/B.Sc/BCA Sem-1 Admission Fee Receipt.
- 11. Candidate must carry their AADHAR Card
- 12. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.
- 13. Selection process is purely based on Merit and transparent depending on available vacancies.
- 14. The candidate must have 12th pass out with a minimum of 45% with recognized board.
- 15. Candidates should be mentally and physically fit to join the NCC.
- 16. Candidates should have proper haircut and clean shaven. (Except Sikh Candidate).
- 17. All candidates will be thermally screened at the selection area.
- 18. All candidates should carry masks and hand sanitizer.
- 19. Certificates of Bonus Marks. All original certificates / photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks / Relaxation will be accepted only during the Selection Process. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Relationship Certificates or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks / Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Selection Process.
- 20. Unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
